Lisa Laubreaux has fun diverting the classic codes of gamebooks, where you can decide to be brave, strong and she suggest other challenges, far from traditional injunctions.







"What is it?", "why?", "what's it for?"... It's not always easy to answer little ones' questions simply! Tell me includes 26 short stories that explain how everyday things work, in a way that young kids from the age of 3 can relate to.

An illustrated hand on each page invites the child to read the explanations and explore the illustrations. The numbered steps help guide the child move forward, or backward, at their own pace.

They can take the time to name, repeat, explain and discuss things with their parents. There are strong visual cues, such as the hand, the winding line and the numbers, throughout the book of discovery.

A shared and interactive reading experience, as the child decides what they want to discover by following the path with their finger.




The illustrations were made using carved wooden pieces, an ancient Chinese technique. The shapes were hand-printed, then scanned to compose the images digitally.




